I'll be honest, a couple of weeks before Christmas hasn't been exactly the ideal time for taking over responsibility for seeing that we provide the best service possible to all who worship at Mount Argus. Involvement in liturgical services should be well within my scope – I've been doing it for long enough - but there have been so many technicalities in all the 'stuff' that goes on in the background – eg. see an instance a little further down the page – that sometimes I don't know whether I'm coming or going. I ask your patience for the present – at least until we get through Christmas and New Year – and then hopefully I can consult more generally on how I can best be of service to you during my short tenure as 'administrator'. I really do appreciate all the assurances of support that I have already received from so many of you, but an even greater support that I genuinely need especially at this time is that of your prayers.

<u>Church Cleaning for Christmas:</u> This Sunday, 22 December, from 5.00 to 6.30 pm, we will be cleaning the Church in preparation for Christmas. We are looking for volunteers to help with this; any help you can give would be very much appreciated. All cleaning material and equipment will be provided.

Advent and Christmas: Leaflets with the times of Masses and Confessions for Advent and Christmas are available at the back of the church.

<u>Masses for Christmas</u>: On Christmas Eve, Tuesday 24 December, there will be the Vigil Mass of Christmas at 6.15 pm, and the Mass of the Nativity at 9.00 pm, with Carols from 8.30 pm and the Blessing of the Crib before the Mass. On Christmas Day, the Dawn Mass will be at 8.00 am and the Day Mass (Family Mass) will be celebrated at 11.00 am. There will be no evening Mass on Christmas Day.

<u>Contactless Donations</u>: You may have noticed that there are new machines at the various doors in the church – two at the back, and one by the side door. I can't take any 'credit' for these (every pun intended!). You would have to regard me as a miracle-worker if you think I could possibly get them ordered and installed in a couple of weeks! Let me stress that they are not intended as being a way to extract more money from you – honestly, you are very generous already in supporting us. Rather, they are intended to facilitate the many people who no longer carry cash nowadays, and who would rather contribute by credit card. So they aren't intended to replace normal cash payments, but are offered as an alternative for those who don't carry cash. Simply follow the instructions on the screens – select the amount, or enter your own preferred amount, on the screen and tap the card on the top.

<u>Christmas Cards</u>: Christmas Cards for enrolment in the Passionist Mass Guild are still available from the office at the monastery during office hours.
