Advent – Preparing for Christmas

The Season of Advent is a time of spiritual preparation for Christmas. You will see that the building of our Christmas crib has already started, preparing the place where the image of the child Jesus will be found on Christmas Day. Perhaps you are already thinking of the Christmas Crib you will place in your home at Christmas. In a letter he wrote in 2019, Pope Francis reflected on the meaning of what he called "the enchanting image of the Christmas Crib". He wrote:

I wish to encourage the beautiful family tradition of preparing the nativity scene in the days before Christmas, but also the custom of setting it up in the workplace, in schools, hospitals, prisons and town squares. Great imagination and creativity is always shown in employing the most diverse materials to create small masterpieces of beauty. As children, we learn from our parents and grandparents to carry on this joyful tradition.... It is my hope that this custom will never be lost and that, wherever it has fallen into disuse, it can be rediscovered and revived.

<u>Feast of the Immaculate Conception</u>: This year we celebrate the Feast of the Immaculate Conception on Monday, 9 December, as the Eighth of December is the Second Sunday of Advent. Because the feast is transferred to 9 December, **it is not a Holyday of Obligation this year**.

<u>Garda Choir:</u> Next Sunday (15 December) at the 11.00 am Mass we will welcome the Male Voice Choir of An Garda Siochana to sing a special Mass as part of our Parish's Golden Jubilee celebrations.

Advent Reconciliation: Our Advent Reconciliation Service and Mass will be held at 11.00 am on Saturday, 21 December.

<u>Church Cleaning for Christmas:</u> On Sunday, 22 December, from 5.00 to 6.30 pm, we will be cleaning the Church in preparation for Christmas. We are looking for volunteers to help with this; any help you can give would be very much appreciated. All cleaning material and equipment will be provided.

<u>Masses for Christmas</u>: On Christmas Eve, Tuesday 24 December, Christmas Eve, there will be the Vigil Mass of Christmas at 6.15 pm, and the Mass of the Nativity at 9.00 pm, with Carols from 8.30 pm and the Blessing of the Crib before the Mass. On Christmas Day, the Dawn Mass will be at 8.00 am and the Day Mass (Family Mass) will be celebrated at 11.00 am. There will be no evening Mass on Christmas Day. <u>Christmas Cards</u>: Christmas Cards for enrolment in the Passionist Mass Guild are now available from the office at the monastery during office hours.

<u>Mount Argus Carol Service and Christmas Party:</u> Our Carol Service will take place in the Church on Sunday, 15 December at 6.00 pm. It will be followed by Advent/Christmas treats and sweets. A collection will be taken up at the Carol Service to support the work of the Capuchin Day Centre. Come along – bring the family - and sing your way towards Christmas.

<u>Crosscare Appeal:</u> Crosscare, the social care agency of the Archdiocese, is once again asking for support for their Christmas Food Poverty Appeal. So far this year, almost 3,000 people, including 1500 children, have needed basic food supplies and support; over a quarter of those coming to Crosscare's Food Poverty Service accessing food support are parenting alone. In the Community Café in Portland Row, staff will have served nearly 10,000 affordable, nutritious meals by the end of this year. As families struggle to cope with the cost of Christmas, there will likely be a spike in the number of people seeking help in the weeks ahead.
